Scene 1 (in the forest)

(The animals are on stage hidden behind trees and bushes, Lrrh is on stage too, playing).

Bee1/2: Hello everybody! Welcome to the forest!

Bird: This is little red riding hood. She lives near the forest.

(Mother is coming on stage holding a basket.)

Mother: Good morning Little Red riding Hood!

LRRH: Good morning mother!

Mother: Grandma is very sick today. Please, take this cake to her.

Lrrh: Yes, mother!

Mother: Be careful little red hood! Be good! Don't talk to strangers!

Lrrh: Yes, mother!

(Mother leaves the stage and Lrrh is going towards the forest. The wolf stares at her looking really hungry!)

Bee1: Little red riding hood is going in the forest.

Bee2: But a big bad wolf lives there!

Bird: The wolf is very hungry!

Rabbit: OH! He wants to eat little red riding hood!!!!

Wolf: (To the audience) Wow! A little girl in the forest!!!

Yummy yummy! Time for breakfast!!!!

(To Lrrh): Good morning little girl! How are you this morning?

Lrrh: I'm fine thanks. Who are you?

Wolf: I'm... Mr Wolf.

Lrrh: I'm little red riding hood. How do you do Mr Wolf.

Wolf: How do you do. What are you doing in the forest?

Lrrh: I'm going to my grandmother's. She is sick.

Wolf: Good girl! Well done!

Lrrh: Goodbye Mr Wolf!

Wolf: Bye!

(Lrrh leaves, the wolf is following her...dribbling.)

Bird: Let's sing everybody.

Song 1

Scene 2 (at Grandma's)

(Grandma is sitting in her "bed". The wolf is knocking at the door pretending he is Lrrh. The animals are in the house too.)

Bee 1: Oh! Help! The wolf is outside grandma's!!!

Wolf: Knock! Knock! Grandma, open the door please! It's me...Little red riding hood!!!!!!

Grandma: Oh! What a nice surprise! My little girl is here.
(Gouh! Gouh!).

Bird: Oh! Nooooo! Don't open the door!

Bee 2: It isn't little red riding hood!

Rabbit: It's the big bad wolf! Don't open the door! Please!

(She coughs and heads to the door. The little animals are terrified. They try to stop her. She doesn't understand. She opens the door. The wolf rushes in and she screams. He howls and he chases her in the room. She drops her cap and shawl. The animals try to help but he finally eats grandma!)

Wolf: Yummie! Yummie! I like grandmothers for breakfast!
Yaaaaaaaouou! (rubbing his belly).

Bird: Poor Grandma!

Bee 1: Now? What do we do?

Wolf: I am still hungry. I like little girls for breakfast too!
Ho! Ho! Ho! Come little red riding hood! I am waiting for you!

(He starts putting on grandma's clothes and pretends that he is her!)

Rabbit: Little red hood is coming soon! We must help her!

Bird: Look at the wolf!

Bee 2: He is putting on grandma's clothes.

Rabbit: Oh, no! He is in grandma's bed!!!

Bird: Little red hood is here!

Bee 1: Be careful, little red hood!!!!

Lrrh: Grandma!!!! Knock!Knock! Grandma!

Wolf: Come in my dear...come in! Ho!Ho!Ho! Food!!!!

Lrrh: Grandma...what big ears you've got!

Wolf: That's because I want to hear a lot.

Lrrh: And...grandma...what big eyes you've got!

Wolf: That's because I want to see a lot!

Lrrh: But grandma...what big teeth you've got!

Wolf: That's because I want to eat a lot!

Lrrh: AAAAAAh! Heeeeeelp!!!!!!!

(The animals close their eyes and scream help, the wolf tries to catch Lrrh, he trips and falls but he catches and eats her!)

Wolf: Wow! I am full now! I am very happy! I am very sleepy too! I'll take a nap. I will go back to the forest later!

(The wolf yawns and falls asleep!)

Bee 2: Oh nooo! Poor little red riding hood!

Bird: Bad wolf! I hate you!

Rabbit: He is sleeping now... But who is at the door?

Bee 1: It's the woodman!

(The woodman is outside the house.)

Woodman: I think I heard: "Heeeeeeeelp!". Grandma!

Grandma: Are you in?!

(He gets in the house and finds the wolf sleeping, wearing grandmas clothes. His belly is swollen.)

Woodman: Oh, no!!!! I must do something! Shhh! Don't wake him up! Let's save grandma!

(He reaches his knife and he tears wolfs fat belly. Grandma comes out first and then Lrrh).

Grandma: Thank you Mr Woodman!

Lrrh: Thank you very much! You are a hero!!!

Bee/Bird/Rabbit: Hurray! Bravo!

(They are jumping and clapping happily)

Bird: Let's sing everybody!

Song 2

Scene 3

Lrrh: What about the wolf Mr Woodman?

Woodman: Don't worry little girl! Let's take him to the forest!

(Grandma, Lrrh and woodman carry mr wolf back to the forest. Mother is in the forest too, looking for Lrrh. She is looking at her watch.)

Mother: Where is little red hood? She is late!!!

Lrrh: Mummy! Mummy!

Mother: Little red hood... mother... mr Woodman... wolf?!

Lrrh: I'm sorry mummy. I am really sorry! I won't do it again! I won't talk to strangers.

Grandma: We will teach the bad wolf a lesson!

Woodman: Yes. Bring me some stones.

(Everybody brings a stone and woodman puts them in the wolf's belly)

Grandma: Let's hide now my children. Let's wait until he wakes up.

(Everybody hides behind the bushes. The wolf wakes up. He yawns. He is dizzy and heavy. He tries to stand up but he is too heavy!)

Wolf: Wow! What a breakfast! I am thirsty now!

Bee 1/2 : Ho! Ho! The wolf is in trouble!

Bird: He is going to the well!

Wolf: Let's drink some water....OOOOOh! Heeeeeelp!

(The wolf falls into the well).

Rabbit: Bye bye Mr wolf!

Mother: The bad wolf is away now! Let's sing everybody!

Bees/Bird/Rabbit: Hurray!!!! Let's sing!

(Everybody comes on stage to sing)
