

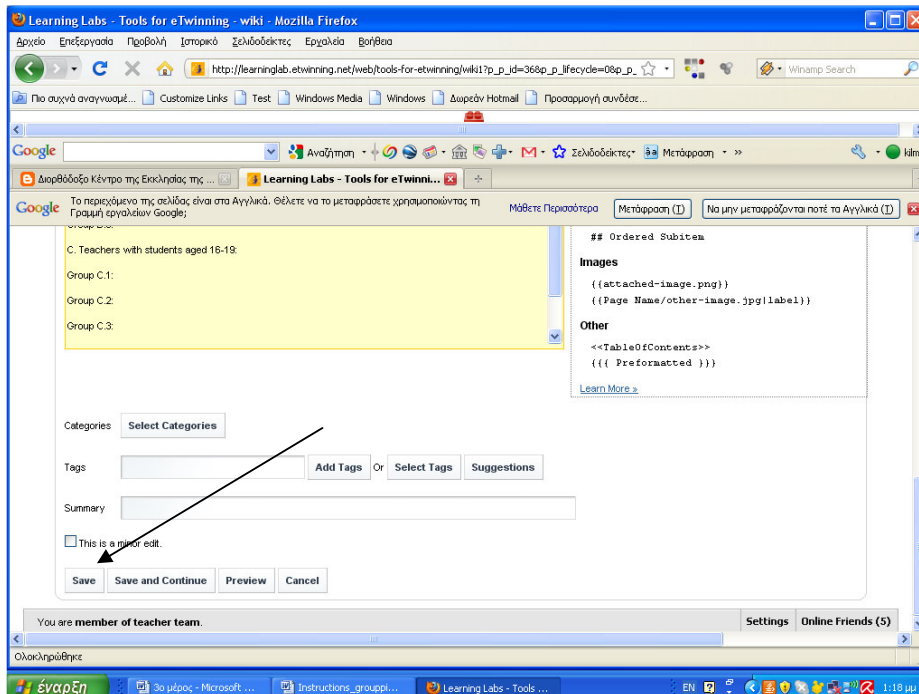
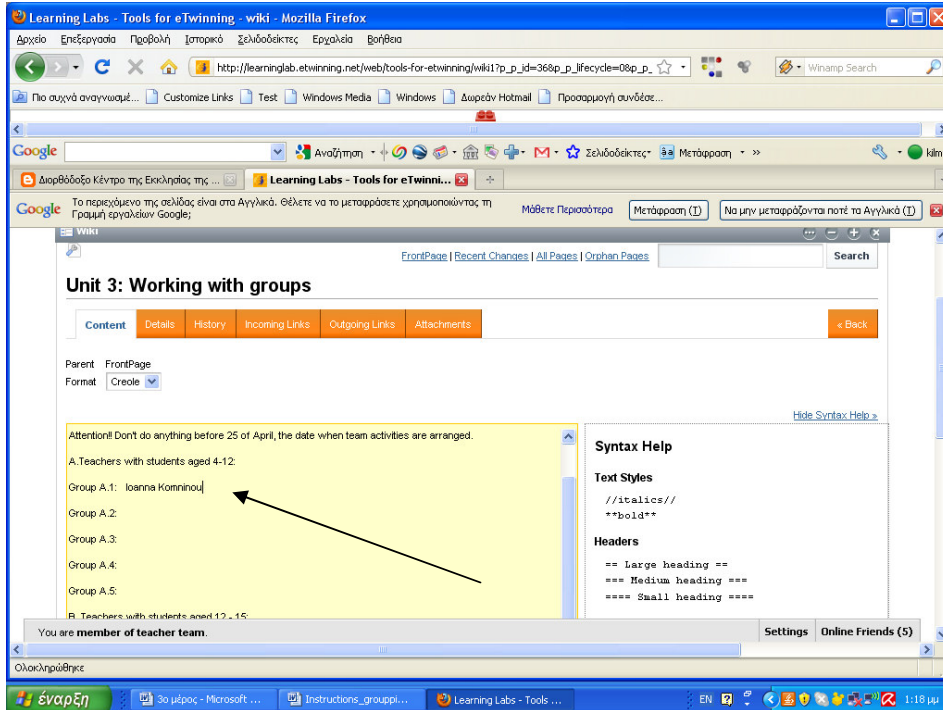
Instructions

1st STEP (grouping)

Please go to the wiki > [Unit 3: Working with groups](#) . Click on **Edit**



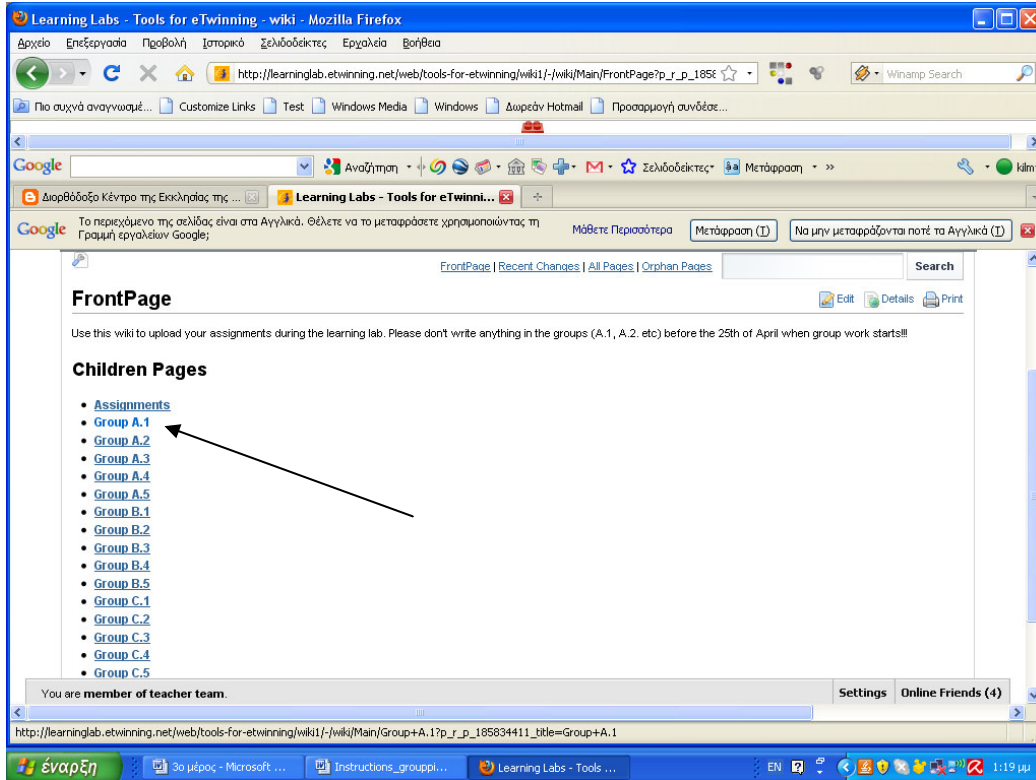

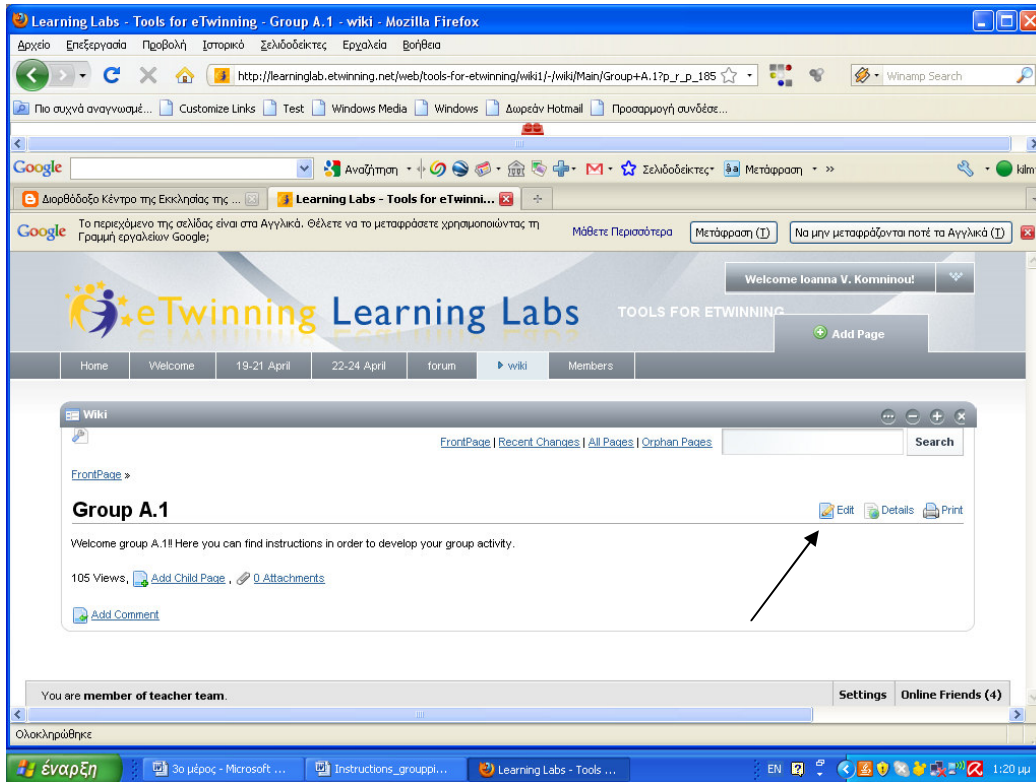

3rd STEP (create your material)

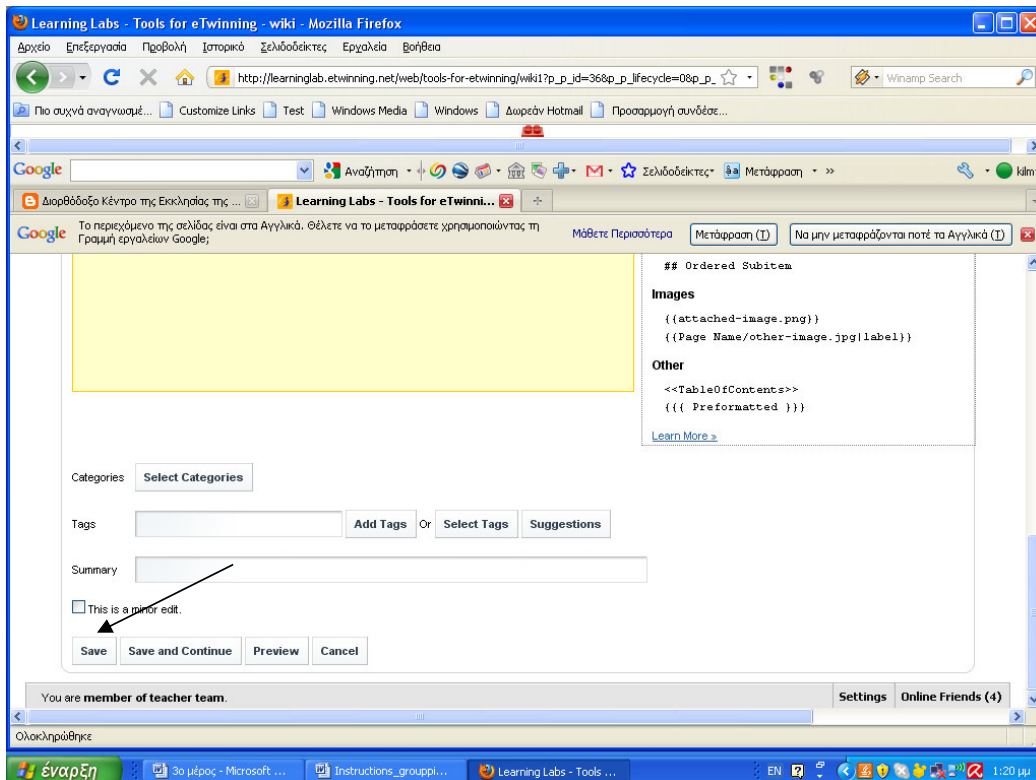
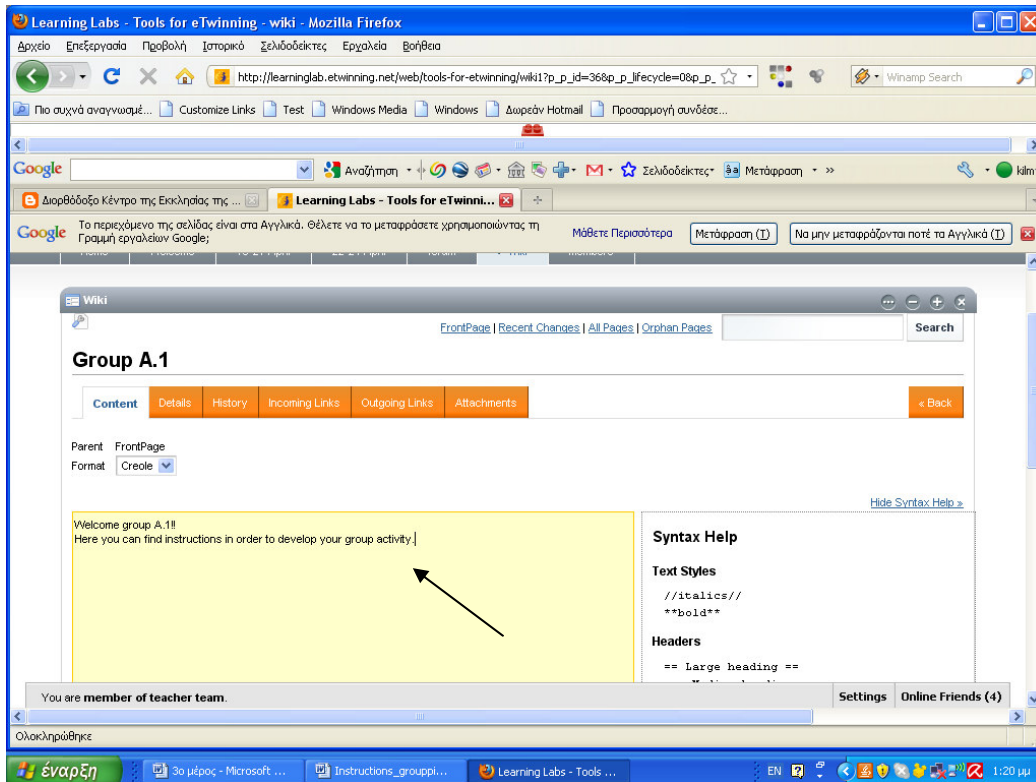
Please go to the wiki and click on the working place that has the name of the group you have chosen. For example, if you have written your name to group A.1, click on this.



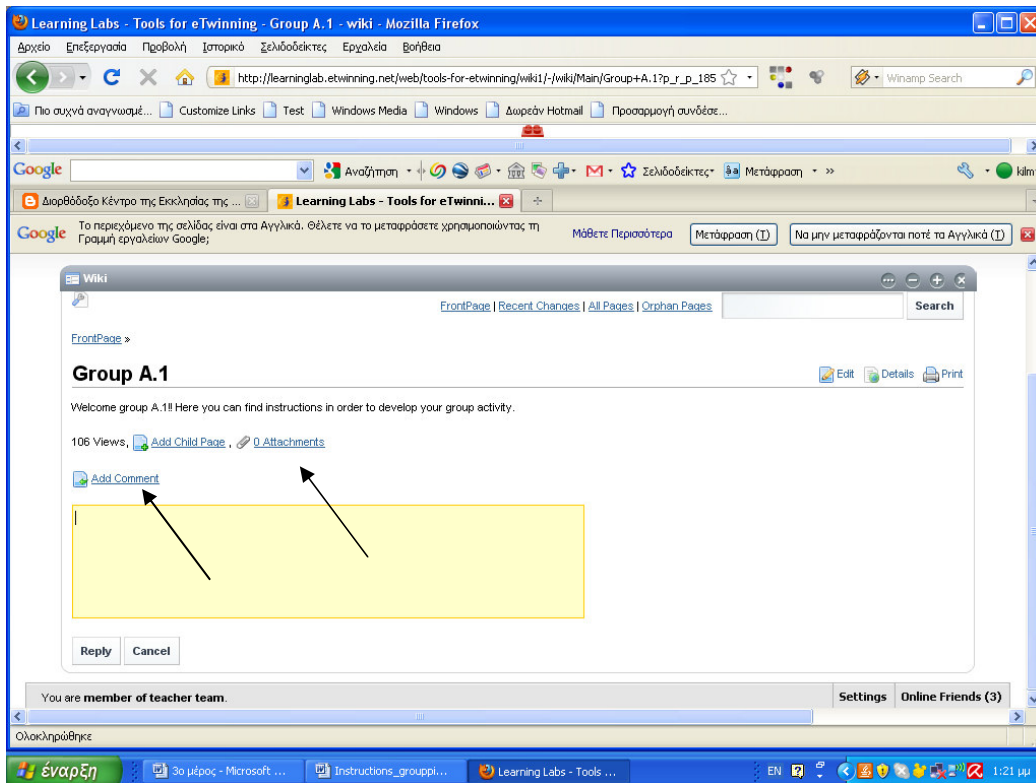
Now you are in your group working place. You can write your text by clicking on **Edit**
