- Eight** Two of your classmates who used to be your good friends have started hanging out together during break. When you ask to join them they say you are not welcome. How do you react?

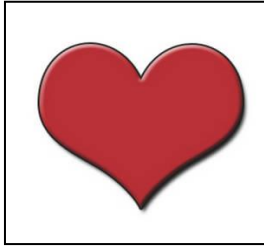

- Two** A group of older students have occupied a certain area at school and threaten you and your friends to beat you up if you come close to that area. How do you feel and what do you do?

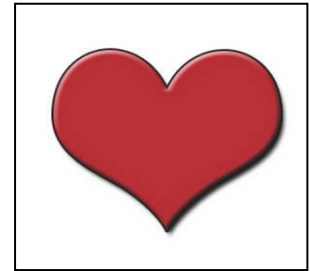
