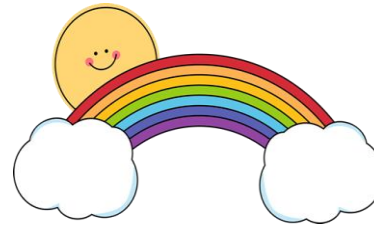


## THE RAINBOW GAME



**Aims:** creating positive atmosphere in the group, promoting polite and friendly behaviour, cooperation, ice-breaking, expressing positive feelings, practising names of colours and imperatives in English.

**Level** beginners – pre-intermediate

**Organisation** groups of 4 to 5 students

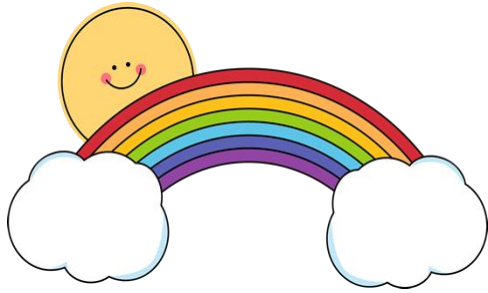
**Preparation** copies of board games, counters, dice

**Time** 20 minutes

**Procedure** Each group receives a board game, a dice and counters. Students throw the dice one by one and move the counters accordingly, following the instructions, depending on the colours. Students can move counters only if they follow the instructions. The winner is the student who gets to the finish first.

# THE RAINBOW GAME



*The meaning of colours:*

**BLUE** Say *hi* to somebody.

**PINK** Tell somebody something nice.

**GREEN** Make high five with somebody.

**PURPLE** Shake hands with somebody.

**ORANGE** Smile at somebody.

**YELLOW** Tell somebody you like her/him.

**RED** Miss one turn.
